

Decades Projects: 1950s-1990s

Each group will research major events and cultural aspects of your decade. Your group will use this research to create a book highlighting your decade. Below is a list of what to include in your book.

To research & Include In Your Book

1. Illustrated cover with a title
2. Table of Contents
3. Chapters-What to have in each
 - a. Three illustrations per chapter
 - b. Three to five sentences caption per illustration, so at least nine sentences minimum per chapter
4. Chapters to include (do not have to be in any particular order)
 - a. Wars
 - b. Politics
 - i. elections
 - ii. legislation
 - c. Rights movements
 - d. Discoveries in Medicine
 - e. Discoveries in Science
 - f. Discoveries in Technology
 - g. Discoveries in Math
 - h. Food
 - i. Can bring in for extra credit
 - i. Clothing
 - j. Music
 - k. Youth Culture
 - l. Movies
 - m. Sports
 - n. Books
5. Back Cover
 - a. Should include biographies of everyone in your group
 - b. Each biography should include a four sentence description
 - c. Must include a picture of each contributor (drawn or printed out)
6. Extra Credit Options
 - a. Food from the decade
 - b. Relics from the decade w/ five sentence blurb about it
 - c. Creative and unique display of information in your book can earn your team extra points (examples: pop ups, moving parts, etc)
7. Decade Rooms
 - a. 1950s-Mrs. Munding
 - b. 1960s-Mrs. Jones
 - c. 1970s-Mrs. Bray
 - d. 1980s-Ms. J
 - e. 1990s-Ms. Danielle in computer lab
